SUMMARY:

Under moderate supervision of the Client Services Director, the Data Analyst supports the Firm’s various departments and is responsible for providing administrative and clerical support in order to ensure effective, efficient and accurate administrative operations. This includes but not limited to: review and analysis of firm time records; monthly reporting of case-specific time and expenses; and responding to additional ad-hoc reporting and change requests. The Data Analyst will assist with various projects to meet departmental goals and objectives.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- An Associate’s or Bachelor’s degree in Business or related field
- One (1) to two (2) years of progressively responsible professional work experience
- Accounting or disbursements experience preferred
- Ability to format and manipulate large datasets in Excel and use Excel formulas; knowledge of other data analysis tools a plus.
- Knowledge of Power BI software a plus
- Strong organizational and time management skills

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:
