Hi Jonathan, Sayed,

Nice to meet you - I'm a PM in CI working in Interaction Integrity. I'm writing to enlist some urgent support from IG to mitigate legal and legitimacy risks we're facing in the Adult Sexual Exploitation, Child Safety and Terrorism space.

Context:

Adult Sexual Exploitation ([StopNCII.org](#)), Child Safety ([NCMEC](#)) and Terrorism ([GIFCT](#)) space are all problem areas which participate in cross-industry hash-sharing collaborations.

All three arrangements involve Meta receiving hashes from an external body (e.g. NCMEC), which we can use internally to match and remove violating content.

We use [REDACTED] as the hashing algorithm for photos and [REDACTED] for videos.

The problem:

All three collaborations were launched with the assumption that [REDACTED] the form of hash used for videos, can be matched on IG. We realised this wasn't the case only in ~January 2022, despite some of these collaborations having been running for years. While the root cause is a feature gap, rather than broken systems, we raised [\\$258090](#) due to the legal and legitimacy risks involved in falling so short of the public expectations we have set.

The risks:

- Legal: [REDACTED] PRIV

- Legitimacy: All three collaborations for Child Safety, Terrorism and Adult Sexual Exploitation are very high-profile given they relate to industry working together to stop high severity harms. Our legitimacy wins from participating in these efforts could easily become a legitimacy loss due to the scale of this feature gap.

Resolving the issue:

We need to implement a client-side implementation of [REDACTED] into the Instagram app so that we can match against content on IG.

Common questions that usually arise at this point are:

- *Why [REDACTED] It's not an effective matching algorithm:* This is correct, we have much more powerful algorithms at our disposal internally. However, [REDACTED] was chosen since it's one of the only algorithms available which is both free to use and non-proprietary, making it suitable for cross-industry collaborations. Other free algorithms (e.g. TMK) were considered and ruled out due to drawbacks with implementing them client-side.
- *Why client side?* We don't believe a server-side implementation will be effective at matching, given the transcoding that takes place when media is posted on Instagram.

Where we could use your help:

- Directing us to the right teams who might be able to build client-side [REDACTED] hashing
- Your buy-in and help communicating that this should be prioritised as a matter of urgency
