About Instagram Teen Accounts



Teen Accounts are Instagram accounts for teens 13-17 that are automatically set to more protective Teen Account settings. These settings aim to help keep teens safe on Instagram by limiting unwanted contact, showing content that's right for their age and helping them manage their time on Instagram.

Teens under 16 need their parent's or guardian's permission if they wish to update their Teen Account settings to be less protective. Teens 16-17 can change these settings themselves, unless their account is supervised by a parent or guardian.

Supervision:

A parent or guardian must [supervise](#) their teen's account before they can:

- Set time limits for their teen's time spent on Instagram.
- Approve or deny their teen's request to make their safety settings less protective.
- See insights about how their teen uses Instagram, including accounts their teen has chats with.
- Make certain Teen Account settings even more protective.
- Allow teens to change their own safety settings to be less protective.

Teen Account settings:

- **Private account:**
 - **New accounts:** When teens 13-17 sign up for a new Instagram account, they will be defaulted to private accounts. Teens under 16 will need their parent's or guardian's permission to switch their accounts to public. Teens 16-17 can change their accounts to public without permission, unless they have set up supervision with their parent or guardian.
 - **Existing accounts:** With the introduction of Teen Accounts, existing accounts for teens under 16 will be set to private, even if their accounts were previously public. They will need their parent's or guardian's permission to change their accounts to public. Teens 16-17 with existing public accounts will not be automatically set to private accounts, and they can keep their accounts public without permission.
- **Messages:** Teen Accounts are automatically set to only receive messages from accounts they follow or have previously connected with.



- **Tags, mentions and content remixing:** Teen Accounts are automatically set to only allow tags and mentions by people who they follow. Content remixing is automatically set to people they follow and follow them back.
- **Potentially offensive comments and message requests:** Teen Accounts are automatically set to hide potentially offensive comments and message requests through the Hidden Words settings. Note: The Hidden Words setting for message requests is not currently supported on web browsers or Meta Quest.
- **Content setting:** Teen Accounts are automatically set to Ages 13+ so that teens see content, messages, profiles and comments generally aligned with movie ratings for ages 13+ across all of Instagram, including from accounts the teen follows.
- **Sleep mode:** Teen Accounts automatically have sleep mode turned on from 10PM to 7AM every day. During sleep mode, Instagram notifications are muted, auto-replies to messages are turned on, and the teen will see a reminder to close Instagram.
- **Daily time limits:** Teen Accounts automatically get a reminder to close Instagram after a total of 60 minutes is spent on the app each day.
- **Live broadcast restrictions:** The ability to start a live broadcast is off by default for Teen Accounts. Note: This safety setting will be gradually introduced for teens. Some teens may not have this setting turned off by default yet.

With supervision, a parent or guardian won't be able to:

- See their teen's search history or chats (only accounts who your teen has chats with)
- Post for them
- Reset their password
