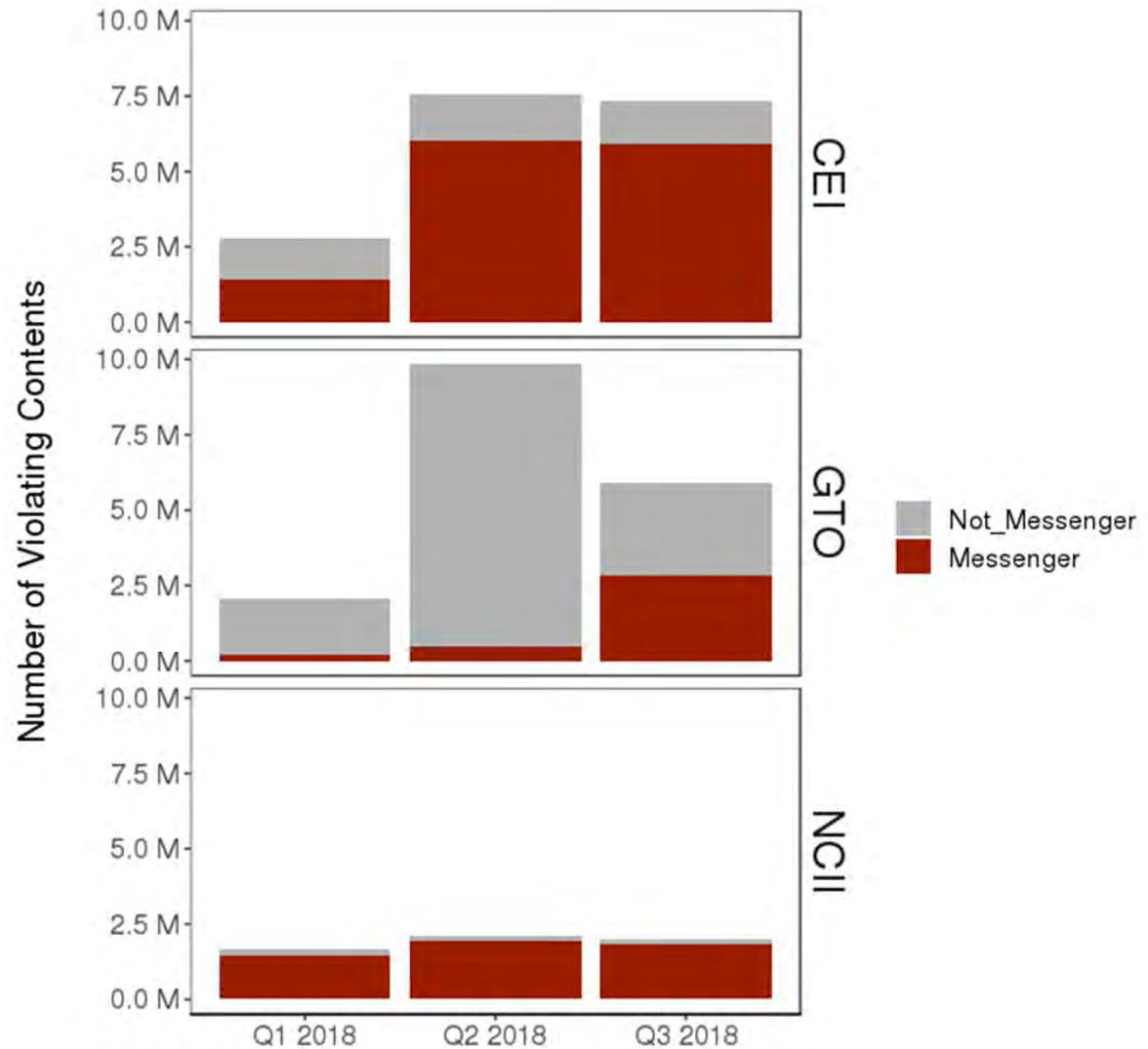

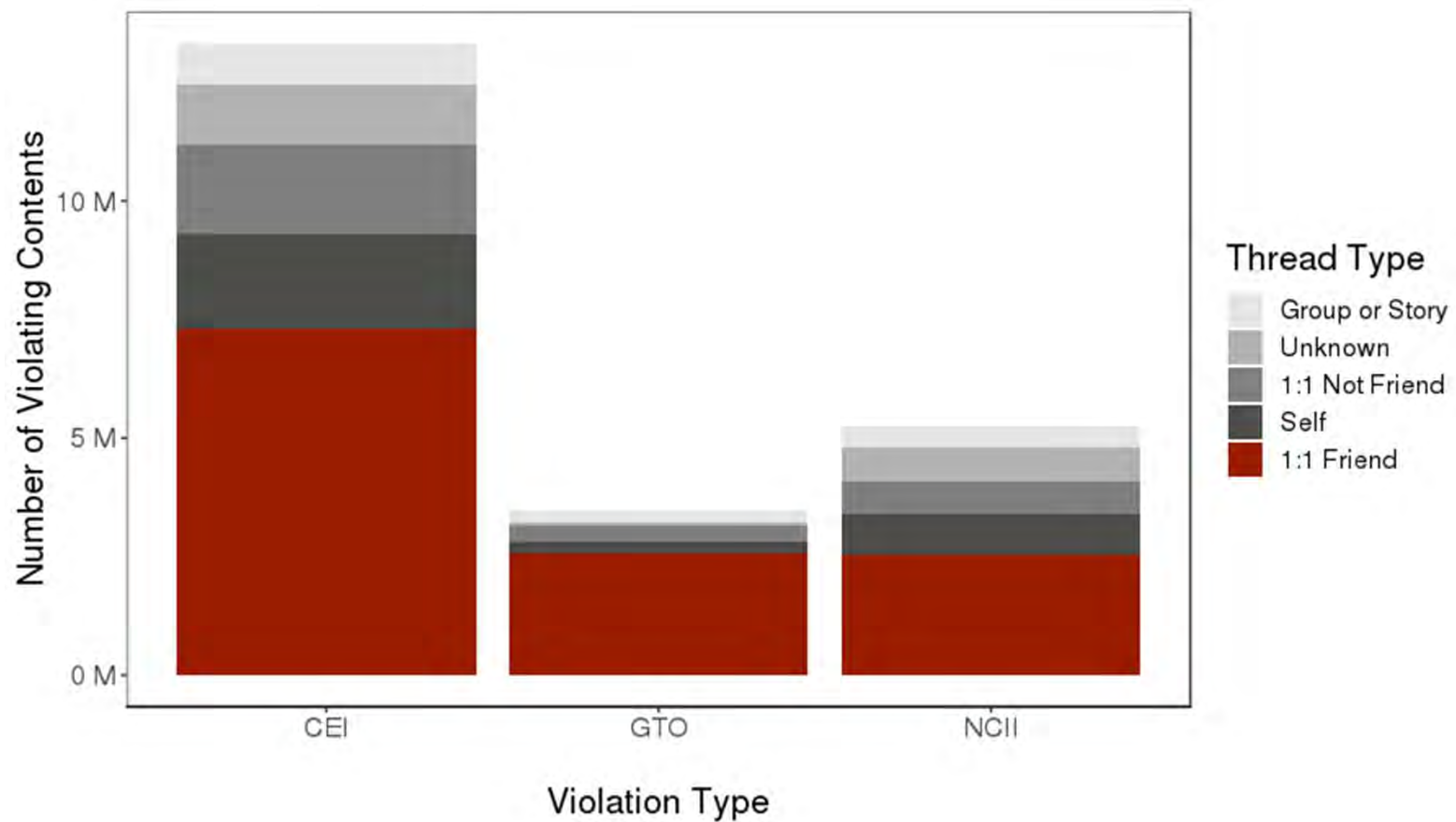

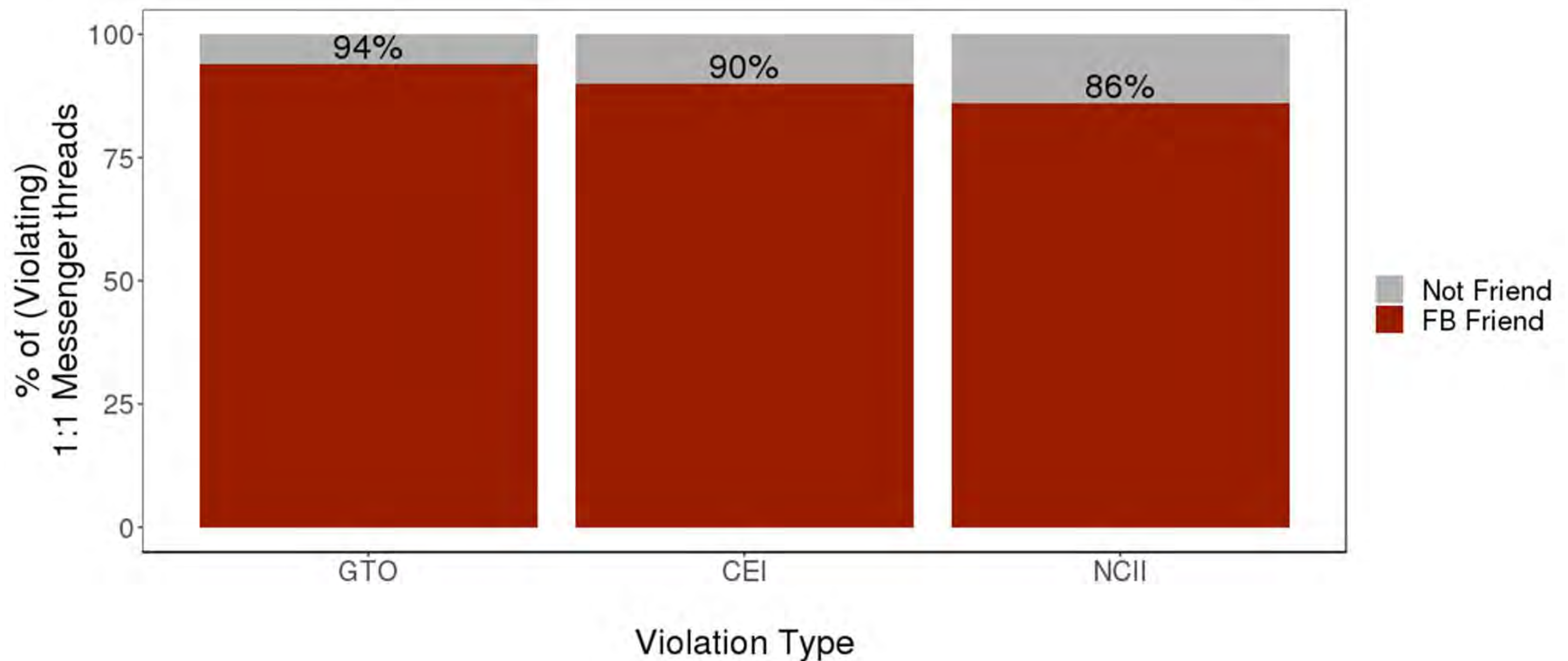
A significant portion of our high intensity content violations are from Messenger.



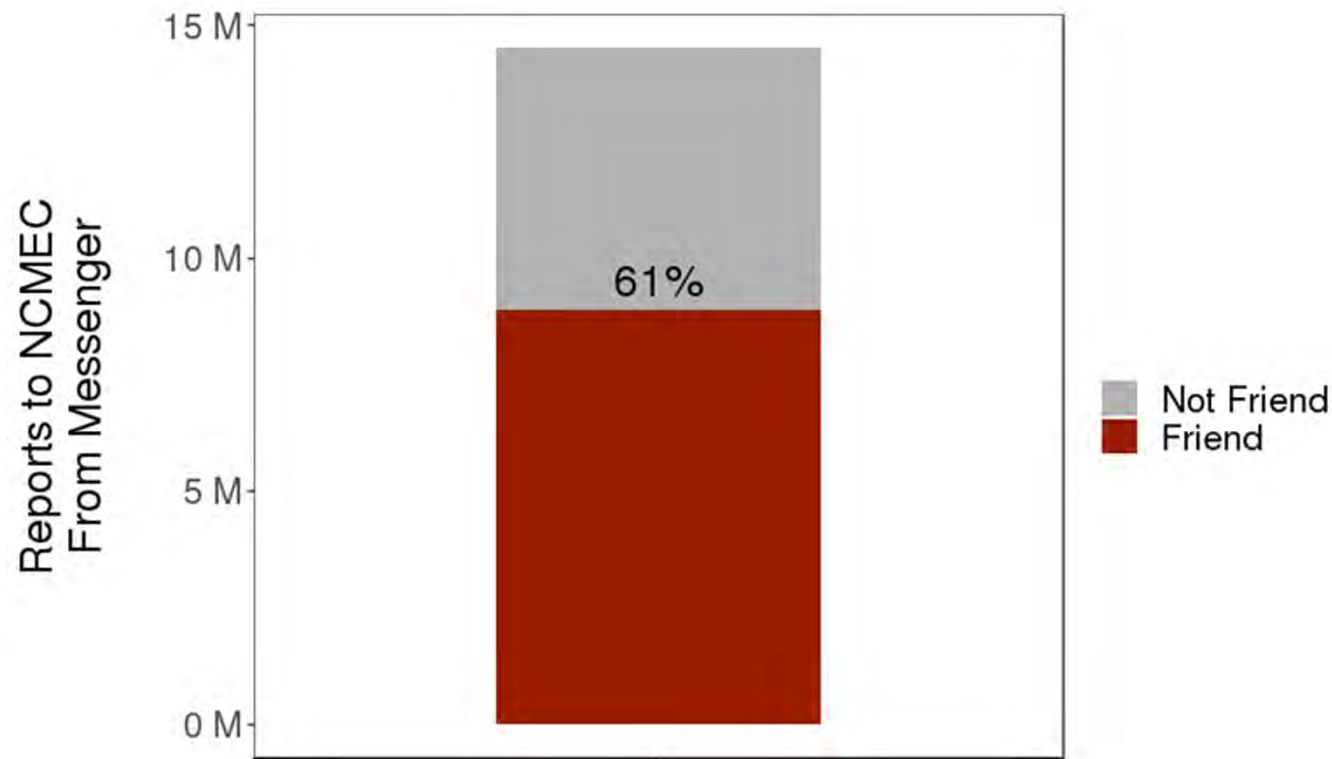
The majority of high intensity content violations in Messenger are in 1:1 threads between friends or self threads.



Of 1:1 Messenger threads having high intensity content violations, a large majority are between FB friends.



61% (8.9M) of NCMEC reports from Messenger are between Friends.



Referrals to law enforcement heavily depend on Messenger evidence.

- In 2018, 98% of proactive terrorism referrals to law enforcement depended on Messenger content.
- In 2018, 600 manual reports for child exploitation (including CEI, Grooming, Minors Contact) were referred to law enforcement based on Messenger content.
 - 36 of these resulted in real-world arrests
