Moving Miki and Pavni to bcc. Bullying is a different team and different problem space than SSI – I think both would be valuable to do dives on as they are both important to understand when it comes to the well-being space and youth.

For background, SSI is one of our hardest problems and more complicated than other problematic content areas for three main reasons: 1. content policy complexity (we allow people to share that they are struggling or having suicidal or self harm/injury thoughts but we don't allow people to glorify or encourage SSI. This is backed up heavily by experts – they feel strongly we shouldn't stigmatize mental health or those seeking help -- but it's simultaneously very difficult content to see and defend, especially for young people) 2. GDPR restrictions in the EU on how we can use technology to proactively detect what EU considers mental/health data 3. Nuance of content and machines to be able to understand context (ex. A photo of train track with a caption that says "it's time").

MARSHA BLACKBURN:

OK. But you're not going to say about the actions. I wasn't asking about speaking in Congress. I was asking about the actions, but we'll leave that where it is. Are you aware of Facebook enabling tracking on the Uyghur Muslims in Xinjiang province in China when they would download Messenger? Are you aware that they've put tracking spyware in Messenger in China?

ANTIGONE DAVIS:

Senator, in fact, we did not put that tracking spyware. We found that tracking spyware, we removed it. We briefed the Senate on it.

MARSHA BLACKBURN:

OK. Why did Senator Blumenthal's office so easily access Instagram and set up this account for a 13-year-old, and then, immediately, they began to receive information about eating disorders and self-harm content? What kind of artificial intelligence are you using that would direct them that way?

ANTIGONE DAVIS:

Senator, we didn't -- we do not direct people towards content that promotes eating disorders. That actually violates our policies, and we remove that content when we become aware of it. We actually use AI to find content like that and to remove it.

MARSHA BLACKBURN:

OK. So, what you're saying is the experience that Senator Blumenthal's office had is an outlier or an anomaly, is that correct?

ANTIGONE DAVIS:

Senator Blackburn, I haven't seen the particular things. I would take a look, but I can tell you that our policies -- it's against our policy.
