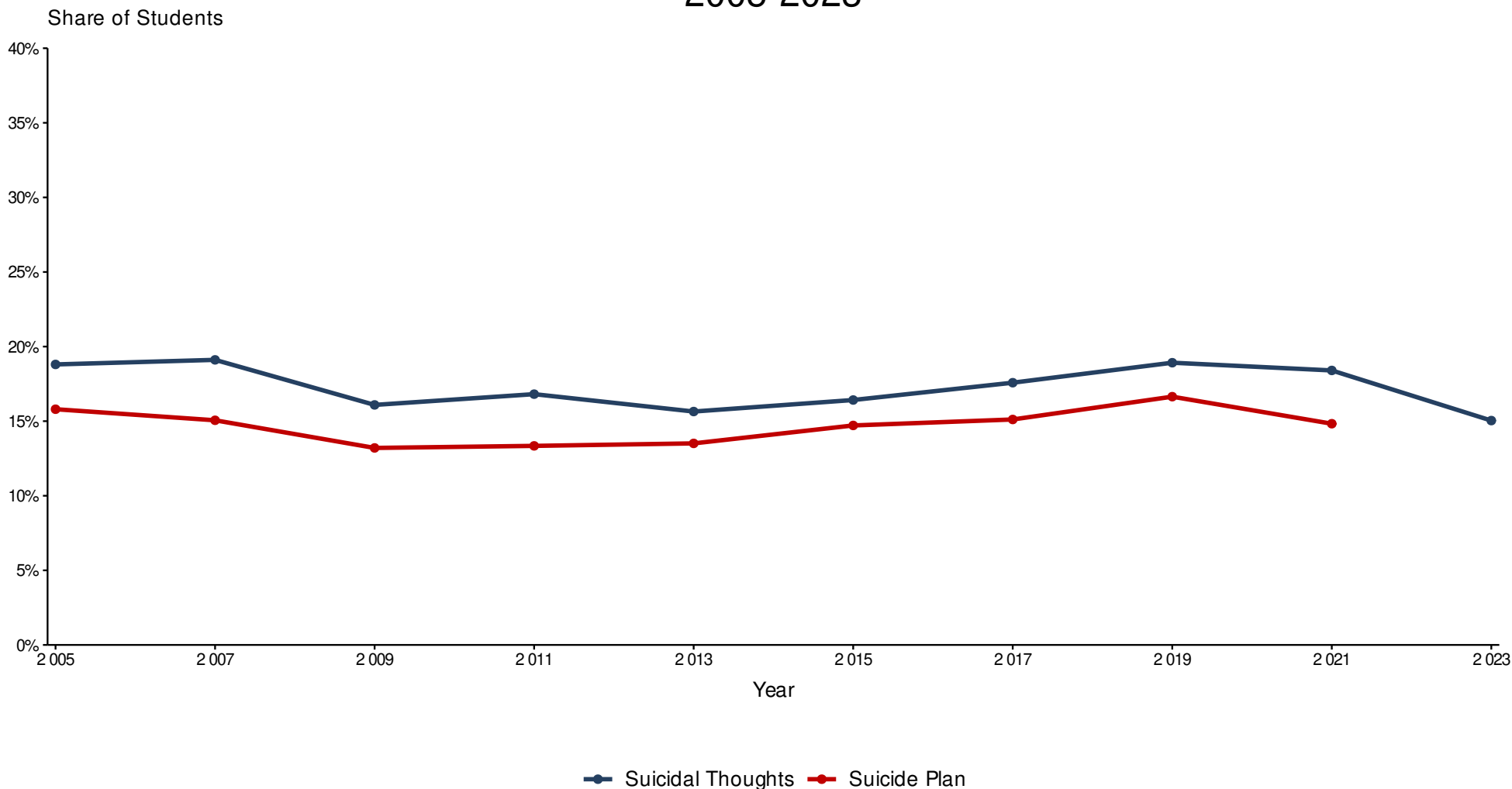


Share of New Mexico High School Students Reporting Suicidal Thoughts and Plans (YRBSS)

Note: This chart shows the share of New Mexico high school students who responded "Yes" when asked if they had made a plan for how they would commit suicide in the last twelve months and who responded "Yes" when asked if they had seriously considered committing suicide in the last twelve months via the national Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System (YRBSS). The YRBSS is conducted every two years. The YRBSS uses a three-stage cluster sample designed to produce a representative sample of 9th through 12th grade students. The target population consisted of all public, Catholic, and other private school students in grades 9 through 12. A weighting factor was applied to each student record to adjust for nonresponse and the oversampling of Black and Hispanic students in the sample.
