Last month, Antigone and myself had the opportunity to participate in a meeting between NCMEC leadership and Mark. We talked about the company's privacy-focused vision (which they understand), the work streams we're spinning up (which they want to contribute to however they can) and also about how the industry should come together on these challenges (which they want to help with). We expressed our commitment to do everything we can to build the safest encrypted messaging service out there.

At the start of the meeting, the NCMEC CEO told us that Facebook has done more for child safety than any other tech company. And the reason they know we're committed to keeping kids safe is because of the work we've done over the years (and particularly he called out the progress on grooming in the past two years). He then pulled out a 200-page printed book, a compilation that enumerates, page by page, real success stories – children saved and abusers put away – thanks to our work.
