>FYI- Last week, we started briefing parenting experts and partners (under NDA) as part of our Nido GTM. The goal is to bring them on board early so they can support our announcement as validators on-platform, with press and at our launch event.

>

>We've briefed four partners so far, and the feedback has been very strong. They see this as an important step for the company, recognize the work that must be going into and are enthusiastic about the potential impact for parents. (Note we also shared this with the internal XFN to generate some excitement amongst the team.) See below for a few quotes:

>- "This is a huge change and I genuinely can't believe you're doing it. It's an amazing opportunity for parents, and it will give them so much confidence that Meta is putting them first. I will do anything I can to make sure parents know about it." (Pediatrician Dr. Hina Talib)

>- "This is a radical change. You're doing something unprecedented and I can't wait to support this, your team should be proud." (Psychologist and parenting author Dr. Aliza Pressman)

>FYI I don't think we can stop recommending teens to adults through AYSF on Instagram. If I'm reading the data correctly that'll stop roughly one third of teen follows that come from AYSF, which suggests that we'd be breaking something meaningful. I'm not sure what's going on yet, it may be because a lot of teens lie about their age, or did at some point, that they get caught up in this. I was as excited about this idea as anyone, but unfortunately I don't see how we can make it work, so my guidance to the team is to explore other ideas(which unfortunately will mean harder to communicate). I know Policy and Public Affairs are very keen on this change, and I'm going to be offline for the rest of this week, so wanted to make sure I shared my take today.
