Hello Karina,

I hope you, your family, and your team are all staying safe and healthy in these crazy times!

Thank you again for offering us the chance to provide feedback for the Instagram parental guide. We have worked with several other child safety and digital experts, and have coalesced our suggestions into the attached word document. I hope you will find it helpful and know that we are happy to discuss it further!

I also wanted to reach out because, as I'm sure you know, given the closing of many schools it is inevitable that more minors will be using Instagram, and likely for longer periods than before. It is a tragic reality that wherever minors flock, predators flock too, and so now is a particularly important time to consider minors' safety. We've spoken with some other social media platforms, suggesting that they use this time to promote safety features on the app and to promote explanations of the kind of users/posts/messages that are reportable and how to block people, etc. Thankfully, we believe they will soon deploy such promotions. So we are writing to ask if Instagram will also actively promote safety features and reporting/blocking information within its app during this unique influx of users?

And last, but not least, we are writing with a serious concern about the new Co-Watching function on Instagram. Considering the reality that Instagram does not yet have fully-functioning algorithms to detect grooming patterns in general, let alone over Instagram Live videos which are already a magnet for exploiters, we are surprised that Instagram would deploy this new feature at a time when adolescents are particularly vulnerable given their increased time online. What can you tell us about this? If it is best to schedule a video call to discuss further I'd be happy to schedule one.

Hello Karina,

As you may have heard, our organization launched a joint international campaign with Collective Shout (Australia) and Defend Dignity (Canada) to raise awareness about the sex trafficking, child abuse, and pedophile-like comments on minors' photos, on Instagram.

It has begun generating press, and we have also alerted interested members of the U.S. House and Senate about the problems we are seeing on Instagram.

This is all material we shared with you earlier, and we are disappointed that these matters have not been addressed.

We hope this campaign will re-open our dialogue to protect children online and re-focus Instagram on these key improvements:

1) Instagram must change its settings so that strangers cannot direct message minors, and Instagram should invest in other age-based safety settings on matters such as account discoverability and geo-tagging, etc.

2) Instagram must fix its algorithm to proactively remove sexualizing or sexually graphic comments on minor's photos,

3) Instagram must update its reporting system so that if someone is reporting a sexual comment on a minor's post it can be reported as such. The "harassment/bullying" selection does not capture the fact that these comments come from adults who are grooming/sexualizing/harassing a child.

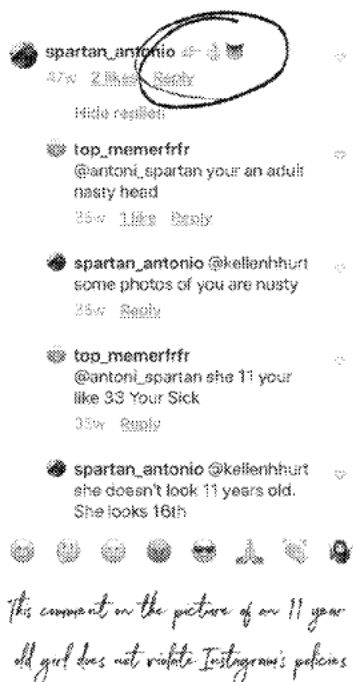
Hello Karina,

We have not heard back from Instagram since our July 8th meeting, despite repeated attempts to follow-up with you, and your initial assurances that you would be in touch regarding the sexual grooming, sex trafficking, and more occurring on Instagram.

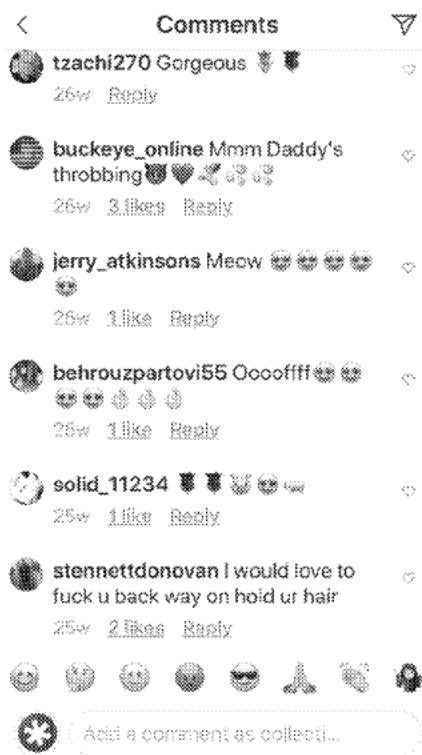
Further, we've been alerted by Collective Shout, an Australian allied organization, that there's a troubling trend of adults commenting in sexual ways on photos of minors. Instagram's algorithms are not catching these, leaving it up to users to report on an individual basis. Further, it appears that Instagram's policies do not recognize sexually contexted emojis as violations when placed under a minor's photos. (Some examples below.)

In a measure of good faith, we are bringing these new and continued concerns to you first. However, if we do not hear back, we will bring these concerns to the public eye and to members of Congress with vested interests in online safety.

Comment on an 11-year-old's photo that was reported and Instagram said it did not violate their policies.

Hello Karina,

I'm emailing again to touch base about coordinating future meetings and dialogue regarding our last meeting about sex trafficking on Instagram.

When we spoke last, you mentioned that you were bringing many of our concerns to internal teams who could examine solutions, such as our concerns regarding grooming via direct messages, the ability to "find" private accounts via their likes or comments on public accounts, the ability for Instagram to recognize who a user is on a device level in order to enforce more strict bans on abusive persons or persons on the sex offender registry, educating users on examples of sexual harassment/grooming, etc so they can report more accurately, etc.

We would welcome a follow-up meeting to explain our concerns to other team members who may be working on specific aspects of these problems, or if you or other team members have specific follow up questions or any requests for additional materials, I am happy to facilitate that.

I also attached a PDF of the memo with concerns that we first gave you in our meeting, in case that is helpful.

Dear Karina,

We are quite disappointed that the meeting scheduled for May 29th did not take place. Sex trafficking on your platform is a common occurrence. Our president just raised this issue at the White House in a meeting on sex trafficking.

As I mentioned to you in my previous email, many teen victims of sex trafficking have indicated to us that they were sold on Instagram. We shared with a group of them that we were arranging a meeting with you on this. Recently, three teen victims of sex trafficking, who were sold on your platform, followed up with us to ask about how the meeting went. They were so encouraged when we told them you were very open to discussing these issues and that we thought you were open to developing some solutions to this huge problem. They are now feeling quite devastated that you have failed to follow through on your promise of a meeting.

We are also extremely disappointed to read articles like [this](#) (or this [tweet](#)) commenting on how your team is meeting with and working to alleviate concerns by individuals advocating for prostitution and sexual exploitation, yet your team is ignoring the devastation happening to countless children on your platform - such as the unsolicited pornography, as well as the predatory targeting, grooming, sex trafficking so many of your minor users are experiencing.

We hope that you will choose to be on the side of curbing sexual exploitation and listening to survivors. A good first step would be meeting with us.

Dear Mr. Leathern,

We are hoping that you might be able to help or direct us to the correct folks at Facebook and Instagram to discuss an alarming trend we are seeing where Instagram is used to groom and then to sell minors for sex acts.

We sent a letter to corporate headquarters a few months ago, but it went unanswered. Surely, it is lost in the piles of correspondence you receive. We sent the attached letter today.

Last December, I was asked to meet with three survivors of domestic minor sex trafficking here in DC, the oldest being just 15 years old, because they wanted us to understand what happened to them. They hoped we could reach out to Instagram and help get this problem solved. Their abuse and exploitation were greatly facilitated using your platform. They showed us message after message they were still getting from strangers asking them for sex. We could hardly believe what they were telling us is a trend. We have since reached out to a number of other survivor-serving organizations and are hearing the same things about the prevalence of Instagram used to recruit, groom, and then sell young people.

We request a meeting with Instagram to discuss this further and possible solutions. We applaud the platform for many great policies and efforts already underway to address sexual exploitation.
